EIKON at a glance

EIKON is an international magazine for **photography and media art**. Quarterly, on an average of 100 pages, it has been offering in-depth articles alongside extensive photo series since 1991. The magazine is published by the Austrian Institute for Photography and Media Art (ÖIP), which is based in the MuseumsQuartier Wien, where it also hosts the **EIKON Schauraum** with a changing exhibition program and a **specialized library**. Furthermore, it distributes the **Edition EIKON**, a limited edition of hand-signed and numbered original photographs by renowned and up-and-coming artists. The magazine EIKON is published in German and English.

In the **Portfolio** freelance authors introduce the work of photography and media artists from all over the world in detailed reports. In their work they follow a high art- and media-theoretical standard. For the section **In Focus** guest editors are regularly invited to examine media-reflective problems as well as current artistic and cultural-political topics. **Arts & Studies** offers students at Austrian art universities a platform. The section **Forum** provides space for topics that go beyond individual works and positions. **Exhibition reviews**, **book reviews**, as well as an extensive **exhibition calendar** and information on competitions and other events complete the issue.

Distribution

In addition, EIKON is distributed **internationally with a focus on Europe**. Museum stores, concept stores and bookstores are supplied directly by us within Vienna. Subscriptions and single issues can be ordered in our **online shop**.

Art Fair Participations

EIKON participates in 14 **art fairs** per year on average, among them major international fairs like **Arco Madrid, Art Brussels, Art Brussels, Art Basel, viennacontemporary, Paris+ par Art Basel, Paris Photo, Art Cologne** and **Art Basel Miami Beach**.

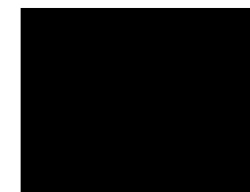

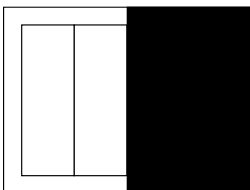

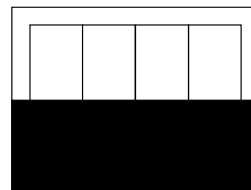

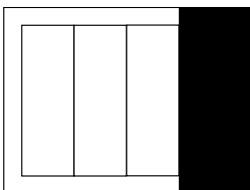

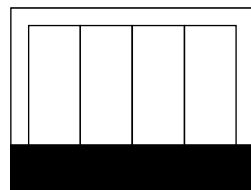

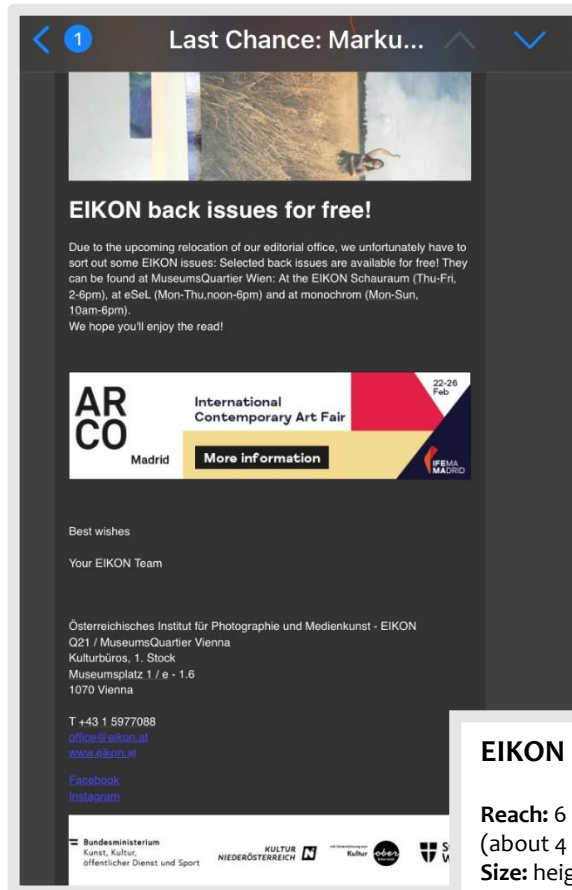

EIKON recommends: Linda Fregni Nagler. Rearranging Photography: Staging the Gaze

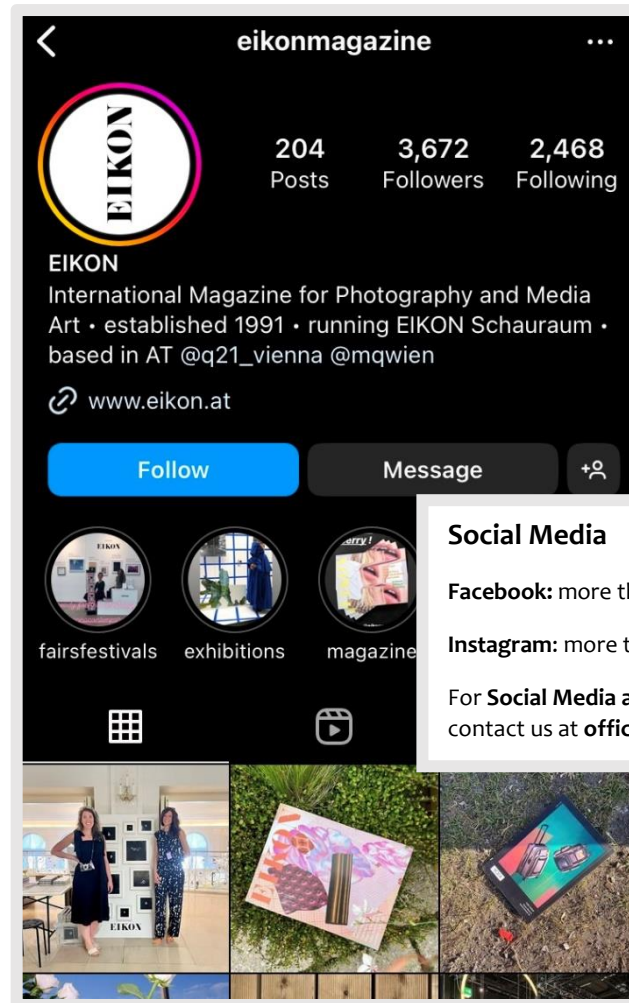
